
Message from Mrs Fynn

Mrs Stalham visited each class from Nursery through to Year 2 meeting the children. When I had a telephone call with her earlier today she described the visit as "the highlight of her week" and was singing the praises of the fantastic children and teachers she had met and the learning she had seen.
