End of half term message

I have been delighted to have seen the children settle back into school so well since September. It has been great to hear about and see first hand the fantastic work that has been completed by children in Nursery all the way up to Year 2. A particular highlight has been listening to the children talk about the new vocabulary they have learnt as well as discussing the stories they have shared in class. It is my hope that all of the new initiatives we have introduced from Drama sessions to our book times will continue to support the children, to build a strong and long lasting positive relationship with literacy. Finally, I just want to congratulate the children for embracing our new school rules. All of the children are aware of the rules and have enjoyed being rewarded for following them. The best part of the half term so far has been being called to classrooms to celebrate children who have either been awarded a Recommendation Card or a Golden Star. I hope the children have a great break and I look forward to welcoming them back to school at the beginning of November.

COVID-19 update

When we return in November, the school is intending to continue running as it has during the past half term. I would like to reassure parents that I am in regular close contact with ECC, Essex's Chief Medical Officer and local Head Teachers where we discuss the localised impact of COVID and potential action that may be needed to reduce the level of risk for children, staff and families. If any changes are needed as cases continue to increase both nationally and locally, I will inform parents immediately. In the meantime, considering the time of year, it is likely that many children will develop a persistent cough. If this does occur, please complete a PCR test before the child returns - LFT should only be used if the child is not displaying any of the three main symptoms. It is very likely that the majority of these tests will return negative considering the number of seasonal colds we normally encounter at this time of year; however, a cautious approach will best protect everyone. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact the office.

Art Gallery

During the past few weeks, the children have thoroughly enjoyed creating pieces of art during their Art sessions. At the end of last week, the children in each class chose 6 pieces of art to be displayed in the school's art gallery exhibition. All of the children had the opportunity to look around the Art Gallery on Monday or Tuesday. Whilst walking around looking at the artwork, the children engaged in discussion about the pieces. Before leaving, the children were able to vote for which year group they felt produced the best work. I am pleased to announce the results below:

1st Place - Year 2 (87 Votes)

2nd Place - Year 1 (86 Votes)

3rd Place - Reception (70 Votes)

4th Place - Nursery (61 Votes)

I would like to congratulate all of the children for their amazing work. I have been inspired by the children's enthusiasm for art during the past few weeks and it is my hope that this experience may have sparked a new interest or hobby for many of our children. As the artwork was so good and the children enjoyed seeing their work displayed, the staff and I are going to offer every family the opportunity to purchase their child's artwork in a frame. More details about this will be sent out by your child's teacher via Seesaw in the near future.
