You will need to hand back your child's artwork to your child's classroom, so that it can be sent to APFS for scanning. Please ensure that the artwork is returned by 19th October 2020. Orders must be placed by midnight on 16th October 2020. Any orders placed after this date will be classed as a late order and will be subject to a handling and postage fee.
