School Admission Transfers for Year 3 – September 2018

We are writing to inform all parents whose children are in year 2 about the admission arrangements for transfer to year 3. The process is changing this year so please read carefully.

Is your child in year 2 at an infant school?

All children in year 2 that are in an infant school **must apply** for transfer to year 3 in 2018. This is the law and there is no longer an automatic transfer to the junior school. A summary information sheet is provided overleaf.

Is your child in a primary school?

If you are continuing in the same primary school you will **not** need to apply. If you wish to change schools for year 3 you need to submit an application by the 15th January 2018.

If you are a resident in Southend and pay council tax to Southend-on-Sea Borough Council you can make an application by using the Council on-line facility at: www.southend.gov.uk/admissions if you are not a resident please submit an application to your home authority.

School Admission Transfers for Year 3 – September 2018 Information sheet for parents/carers

What has changed for transition to year 3?

- Children in year 2 at infant schools must apply to transfer to year 3 at the Junior school. Apply any time between 14th September 2017 and 15th January 2018.
- Children in primary schools that are not changing schools do not need to apply and move to year 3 without any administrative process.

Why must children in infant schools apply to move to year 3 in the Junior schools?

It is the law

How will applications be considered?

The five Junior schools in Southend-on-sea have the following admission criteria:-

- Pupils in Public Care/previously in public care
- Pupils attending the infant school
- Pupils in the catchment area with a sibling in the school or at the partner Junior school
- Pupils in the catchment area
- Pupils outside the catchment area with a sibling at the school or at the partner Junior school
- Pupils outside the catchment area
- Remaining applications

The full admission policies are available in the Primary admission booklet 2018 which is available on www.southend.gov.uk/admission

Children in the infant school of the 'partner' Junior school will therefore have priority on the admissions ranking.

When do I apply and when do I hear about the offer?

The closing date for both on-line and paper applications for Reception year and Year 3 is 15th January 2018.

Offer day is a national day: 16th April 2018
