**The morning after the night before** - I know many of us will be looking forward to the final on Sunday with huge anticipation - this is not something that happens every day! As Monday is 'Break The Rules Day', I would like to add an additional rule that the children can break - be at school on time. On Monday, the children will be able to arrive at school up until 10:30am without receiving a late mark. The school will be open at normal time and Breakfast Club will still be open for those who wish to come. Those children, who are in school, will be completing some fun activities until 10:30am when normal lessons will resume. It is our hope that this may allow for a later night/extra time in bed before they are ready to start the final full week of school.

If you are planning for your child to arrive at school at your normal time, please go to your child's class door at the pre-arranged staggered time. If you are arriving after 9am, please enter the school via the office. Once the children have entered the office, they will be able to walk to their classroom via the indoor corridors. Anyone who arrives after 10:30am will be marked as late.

**Parking Permit** - From September, we will be offering a Parking Permit which will allow parents to park in Rectory Road Car Park. The permit is valid weekdays during term-time, up until 9:30am and between 2:45pm-4pm **ONLY**.
