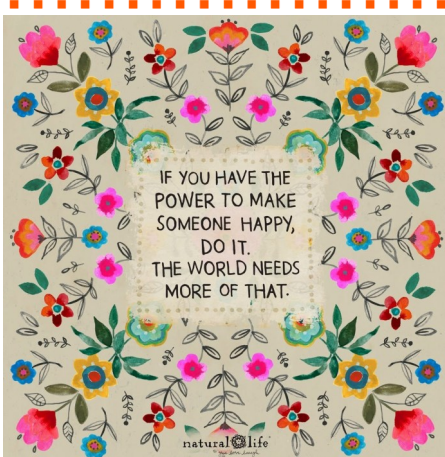


Message from Mrs Fynn :

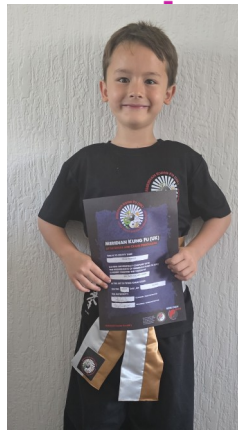
Congratulations to our fabulous catering team who had their unannounced food hygiene inspection this week. We are pleased to let you know they have maintained their 5* rating!
