## News ...

**Christmas Fayre** - On Saturday 27th November, the school's Parents Association ran our Christmas Fayre event. Visitors were able to play games, visit Santa, play mini golf, complete craft activities and purchase a range of items. I would like to take this opportunity to thank the members of the PA who gave up their time, not only on Friday and Saturday last week but for the weeks leading up to the event. To complete an event like this takes a committed team and many people volunteering. I would also like to thank the members of staff who gave up their time to support the PA too. I am delighted to let you know that the event raised £2,539. This money will be donated to the school and will allow me to fund projects and opportunities throughout the year. Thank you to everyone for supporting the event - your support makes the long days the PA spent organising worth while.

**Parking** - It has been brought to my attention that the level of traffic and parking around the school has started to increase as we have moved closer to winter which has led to several incidents. One parent spoke to me this week about how her child was nearly hit by a car. I fully understand that families may need to use the surrounding roads to park but I would ask that we all take additional care when closer to the school and park with consideration for those who have large buggies and prams. From September, we have been offering a Parking Permit which allows parents to park in Rectory Road Car Park. The permit is valid weekdays during term-time, up until 9:30am and between 2:45pm-4pm ONLY.
