**COVID-19** - I would like to ask everyone to remain extra vigilant with regards to possible CVOID-19 cases. Considering the level of infection for children between the ages of 5 to 9 continues to be high, we have still had little disruption. I would like to thank everyone who has started to take part in twice weekly testing and when suggested have taken their children for PCR tests. Both of these actions would have supported the school community to keep our infection rates low. My staff monitor any potential symptoms on a daily basis, this monitoring plays an important part in quickly identifying and reducing any possible risk for others. As you are all aware the rules changed in August allowing children who have been in close contact of a positive case of COVID-19, to still attend the school if someone they either live with or have been in close contact with has contracted the virus. If your child is a close contact, please let your child's teacher know so we are able to be extra vigilant also. As always, I would like to thank all families for their support during this long lasting pandemic - without your support the school would not have been able to respond as effectively during this difficult time.

Year 2 - Junior school admissions for September 2022 - Parents of all current Year 2 children need to make a formal application to the Council for a junior school (Year 3 place). Parents can apply via the website <a href="www.essex.gov.uk/admissions">www.essex.gov.uk/admissions</a>. The junior admission round opens on Monday 8 November 2021, for parents of children to apply for a junior school (Year 3) place for September 2022. The statutory national closing date for applications is 15 January 2022.
