### This Week's News:

**Transition Days** - Next Tuesday and Wednesday, the children will be completing transition events in their new classes. These sessions are deigned to allow them to meet the adults who will be working with them next year. The sessions will take place in their new classrooms. When the children leave school on Tuesday they will have a letter informing you who their teacher will be as well as a letter from their new teacher.

**Open Evening** - On Tuesday night, the children will also bring home with them information about how you can speak to your child's new teacher. Open Evening is unable to be completed in its normal format; however, parents will have the opportunity to sign up to a five minute Zoom session with their child's new teacher. It is my hope that this short discussion will allow parents to put a name to a face, ask any questions you may have about the coming year and share any information you feel is needed. If you require more time to meet with your child's new teacher after this meeting, my team will be happy to meet again.

### **News Continued...**

**Sports Day** - The current guidance will allow for Sports Day to go ahead albeit in a very different format from normal years. The plan is to complete the event in year groups throughout the day on Friday 9th July. Each Year Group will complete their session during the times set out below:

- Reception 9:15am 10:15am
- Year 1 10:30am 11:30am
- Year 2 1:40pm 2:40pm

Nursery will complete a separate event on Tuesday 13th July - details about this event have been sent out by Mrs Bennett this week.

Each class will be split into 2 groups of 15 children. Each group will complete 6 different timed activities in areas marked around the field. Up to 2 people, including younger and older siblings, can attend the event per child. Children who currently attend the school's Nursery (Explorers) will be able to attend the Nursery whilst you are watching their sibling during the Sports Day event - this will have no cost implication on parents. To ensure that we are COVID compliant (no more than 30 in a group outside) we will not be able to admit more than two. From discussions I have had with some parents, I know this is going to be difficult; however, these rules cannot be changed. Many schools have either cancelled the event or are completing it with no parents in attendance. Throughout this pandemic, my team and I have been determined to complete as many events and activities as possible; however, safety for all and following the current guidance is a must. Tickets will be needed to enter the event - these will be numbered and collected when entering for Sports Day. Once you receive your ticket, please add the information that is asked for on it and give this to a member of staff on the gate on the day of the event. These tickets will then be used for contact tracing purposes.
