<p><b>Introduce and teach how to logon and use basic functions of Seesaw.</b></p> <p>Skills to be covered:</p> <p><b><u>Health, Well-being and Lifestyle</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I can explain rules to keep us safe when we are using technology both in and beyond the home.</li> <li>I can give examples of some of these rules. <b>Topic 3 - Word Processing and Typing Autumn 2 6 Weeks</b>	
Skills to be covered: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>I can type words and simple sentences using a keyboard or tablet.</li> <li>I can use the 'space bar' to create a space between words, the 'delete' key and the 'caps lock' key and know which keys to use for punctuation such as full stops.</li> </ul>
