Activity 1



Choose 3 toys



Get them ready to jump! You will need to have a starting line.



Help them to **jump** across the water.



Measure who did the longest jump and who did the shortest jump.
Compare. (use bricks to help you measure like you used in the bridge measuring activity) Keep practising.

Challenge - record your results on a chart or as a picture.

Use a ruler or tape measure to measure in cm or m (centimetres or metres).

Activity 2 Now try with your family. Have a starting point. Each person jumps. Measure how far they jumped. Who did the longest jump? Who did the shortest jump? Have fun jumping.

Remember to use these words - measure, length, longer, shorter, equal, estimate, compare.
