	pencils for drawing and writing, paintbrushes, scissors, knives,
	forks and spoons.
Literacy	Read simple phrases and sentences made up of words with known
	letter-sound correspondences and, where necessary, a few
	exception words. Re-read books to build fluency, understanding
	and enjoyment.
	Form upper and lower case letters correctly. Spell words by
	hearing the sounds and writing the matching letters.
Mathematics	Comparison of number - more less /fewer, one more / less.
	Composition of number (adding differnet pairs of numbers to get
	the same total, eg 6+4=10, 7+3=10). Comparison of mass and
	capacity (heavier, heaviest, light, lightest, full, empty, partly full
	etc). Continue, copy and create patterns with colours and shapes.
Understanding of the	Understand the effect of changing seasons on the natural world
World	around them. Recognise that people have different beliefs and
	celebrate special times in different ways. Explore the natural
	world around them. Describe what they see, hear and feel whilst
	outside. Understand that some places are special to members of
	their community.
Expressive Arts and	Sing in a group or on their own, increasingly matching the pitch
