#### News ...

We have been delighted to welcome lots of new children and families to school this week, not just in Nursery and Reception but in Years 1 and 2 as well. There has been a lovely feeling of calm, enthusiasm and happiness in school as we start a new phase in the life of HINS.

I hope you received my email in light of yesterday's news about Queen Elizabeth II. I will plan a special assembly to celebrate her remarkable life in the coming week. We will keep you informed of any changes as we get more information.

School forms - We have added new forms to the website which need to be completed as soon as possible. If you would prefer to call the main office and complete the forms over the phone, please call between 9am and 3pm and Mrs Reader will complete the forms with you.

To ensure the school can effectively safeguard your child we require accurate information about who has permission to collect them from school this year. Please complete the **Child Collection Permission Form 2022-2023** to inform us of all adults who have permission to collect your child. For safeguarding reasons, ad-hoc collections by any other adults will need to be communicated with the school in advance of collection.

**Photo permission form 2022-2023** needs to be completed for all children in Year 1 and 2 please. We have already collected this information for Nursery and Reception as part of the Induction process.

Curriculum Meetings - During the week beginning 19th September 2022, the teachers from each year group will hold 2 curriculum meetings, the first at 9am and the second at 6pm in the school hall. Parents will have the option to attend whichever meeting suits them. The meetings will allow the teachers to explain all the information linked to curriculum, homework and the expectations for your child's new year group. If you are unable to attend either meeting, you will be able to access all of the paper work and presentations on the school's website by Monday 3rd October 2022. The dates for the individual year groups are:-

- Reception Wednesday 21st September
- Year 1 Monday 19th September (this will be moved to Monday 26th if the Queen's funeral is on 19th)
- Year 2 Thursday 22nd September

Nursery does not have a meeting as these areas were covered in the Induction presentations back in the summer term.

**PE days** - The children will need come to school wearing active wear on the days that they have PE which can include a school PE kit. The children can wear jogging bottoms, shorts, sports leggings, t-shirts, jumpers, hoodies and any other type of clothing you may wear when completing physical activity. The clothes the children wear on their PE sessions do not have to be in keeping with the school colours.

All Reception and Key stage 1 classes will have PE twice a week plus a lunchtime multi-skills session once a week -

PE Days -

Stars - Monday and Friday Rockets - Monday and Friday Moons - Monday and Friday

Planets - Monday and Wednesday Astronauts - Tuesday and Wednesday Flying Saucers - Wednesday and Thursday

Galaxies - Tuesday and Thursday Asteroids - Wednesday and Thursday Satellites - Monday and Thursday

If you require any additional support with supply of PE kit, please contact Mrs Burls by phoning the main office.

No jewellery should be worn on PE days in Year 1 or Year 2 and should not be worn at all in Nursery or Reception due to the physical nature of their curriculum. Staff will not be able to take earrings out and tape is no longer to be used to cover jewellery. If your child arrives at school on their PE day wearing jewellery, they will not be able to take part.

#### News ...

Breakfast club and after school club - If your child is attending either Breakfast Club or After School Club please complete a new registration form for this year to ensure the staff have up-to-date details about your child. These forms are available on the website. We have also set up a dedicated email address for parents to use for After School Club, where all ASC queries or bookings can be sent. This will supersede all previous booking arrangements, and will hopefully streamline the process. The email address is: Afterschoolclub@hadleigh-inf.essex.sch.uk

Parking Reminder - Please park considerately in the roads around school. Avoid double parking as this makes it very difficult to maintain a good flow of traffic around school but also means that emergency services would struggle to get down the road if needed. Please do not park across residents' driveways. We continue to offer a Parking Permit which allows parents to park in Rectory Road Car Park. The permit is valid weekdays during term-time, up until 9:30am and between 2:45pm-4pm ONLY. Lost Property - There will be a lost property rail outside the reception on Friday's after school if your child has lost any items.
