The children had great fun on Thursday this week on World Book day—they looked fantastic and really enjoyed talking about their favourite books. Thank you for your support with providing costumes.

I am excited to share that we have two new members of staff joining us at HINS. Miss Hoath has joined us today in the role of Attendance and Wellbeing Practitioner, her role is similar to that of the one previously undertaken by Mrs Burls. This week the Reception children have been learning the story of the Three Little Pigs, when I visited their classrooms it was lovely to chat to them about the story and watch them role play building houses with straw, sticks and bricks.
