This Week's News:

I would like to offer a warm welcome back to all of our families who have returned after the Summer Holidays and to those who are joining the school for the first time. We have planned an exciting year ahead with many opportunities for the children to complete fun-filled educational activities. We will continue to develop and improve our provision during the year to ensure that, as a school, we enable the children to meet their full potential.

As part of the school's continued focus of improving wellbeing, we will continue to complete daily wellbeing sessions alongside our active daily kilometre. As a school, we have set a target to collectively travel around the world (40,075km) during this academic year using each child's daily kilometre contributions. Each child will be able to contribute up to 185km per year by completing all of our daily active sessions. The children will receive certificates to celebrate 10km, 25km, 50km, 100km and 150km. We hope that the whole school community will support the children and staff in our journey around the world. I will keep parents informed about the school's progress throughout the year.

I would like to thank all of the parents who completed the feedback questionnaires at the end of last year. Please find the results of the feedback attached to this newsletter. As Head Teacher, I will continually work to improve the provision we offer your children. I am looking forward to working with children, parents, staff and governors over the next academic year to improve the overall learning experience the children are given during their time at the school. I would personally like to take this opportunity to thank two long-serving governors who have come to the end of their terms as Trustees of the School after many years of service. Roland Armitage (Vice Chair) has served on the Governing Body for 10 years. During his time as a governor, Mr Armitage has supported the school in a wide range of ways including strategically guiding the school through Academy conversion and supporting the school to improve the facilities and grounds that the children have access to. Darren Braithwaite (Chair) had served on the Governing Body for 10 years. Mr Braithwaite has played a huge part in the school's successes over the past 10 years. He was an integral part of the school's academy conversion and has held both myself and Mrs Dalley to account to ensure the school delivered high quality provision for the children. I am looking forward to working with Mr Ian Holroyd and Mrs Lorraine Evans who will step into the roles of Chair and Vice Chair respectively from their current posts on the Governing Body.

During the week beginning 17th September 2018, the teachers from each year group will hold a Curriculum Meeting. The meetings will allow the teachers to explain all the information linked to curriculum, homework and new expectations for their child's new year group. 18th September 2018 - Year 1 Curriculum Meeting / 19th September 2018 - Year 2 Curriculum Meeting / 20th September 2018 - Reception Curriculum Meeting Each year group will hold two meetings one at 9am and one at 6pm. We will continue to hold half termly parent workshops which will allow parents to work alongside their children in a range of curriculum areas. The dates for these workshops will be published next week.

Finally, I would like to draw parent's attention to the dates for parents evening. The first parents evenings of the year will be held earlier than previous years and will take place on Tuesday 16th and Thursday 18th October 2018. A letter will be sent out in the coming weeks for parents to request their meetings.
