Sea-Life Adventure visit

The Explorers visit to the Sea-Life Adventure on 11th May is all booked now.

If you booked a place on the trip we will be requesting your payment of £7.50 per person soon (£15 for a child and an accompanying adult). You will be asked to pay via the School Money system and we will let you know when the system is ready for your payment.

If you informed us that you have Annual Passes there will be no charge.

I have booked us for morning entry at 10.30am so we will need to meet at around 10.15am to put our wristbands on.

Afternoon entry is booked for 1pm for those of you who preferred the afternoon session.

I will send a more detailed letter nearer the visit. Hopefully weather permitting we can all gather together on the beach for a picnic lunch between 12 noon and 1pm.

For those children who usually attend Nursery on Wednesdays but are not attending the visit please remember there will be no Nursery sessions that day.
