Sports Day - Sports Day tickets will be sent out by the end of next week. **I would like to remind parents that everyone attending the event will need a ticket including babies.** I had a meeting with Essex County Council on Monday who confirmed that there are no exemptions for the 30 people currently permitted to attend events outside. When you receive your ticket(s) you will also receive further information linked to how the event will run.

Year 2 Leavers - I am still planning to run the Year 2 leavers celebration assemblies following the arrangements set out in the previous letter. Further information about these celebrations will be sent out at the beginning of July.

Deanes Summer Holiday Programme - is running from Thursday 22 July—Tuesday 31st August 2021.
