#### Phonics:



### <u>Maths</u>

Count from 0 to 20 and back again. Use the song to help you:  $\frac{https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=srPktd4k}{O8} \ Now \ try \ counting back form \ different \ numbers \ to \ 0 - use \ your \ numberline \ to \ help \ you.$ 

Today we are going to do some taking away or subtraction. Now using the fingers of one hand to be the passengers in the boat, how many ways can you take away the passengers? Here is one to start you off: 5 - 1 = 4. Five take away one is / leaves four.
