Children In Need

This will be sent to the charity to add to this year's fundraising amount. Children in Need is a fantastic charity which helps so many children and we are proud to

be able to do our bit to help. Thank you to parents, children and staff from making the day such a success.

Christmas starts with a bang - On Wednesday 1st December our official Christmas celebrations will begin. On this day the children will be invited to attend school wearing a Christmas hat/head wear. During the day, each class will complete our annual festive Daily K. We started this tradition two years ago and the children loved it so we decided that this would be a nice way to start our festive celebrations. To mark the beginning of our Christmas celebrations the kitchen will cook a special menu - Pigs in Blankets, chips and beans with a Christmas biscuit. On Wednesday 1st December, each class will also receive their first personalised letter from the International Elf Service. These letters will arrive everyday up until Christmas Eve. A picture of these letters will be sent via Seesaw each day when the school breaks up for Christmas. It is our hope that the first time children hear about this will be when they receive a special package in class before the 1st.

Bedtime stories - Bedtime stories will also take place on Wednesday 1st December 2021. This event will take place in classes. Children will be invited back for a story time in class. To take part in this event, the children will be invited to attend in their pyjamas and dressing gown with the option to bring slippers to change into. All children should be dropped off at, and collected from, their own classroom (Each child will need to be collected by an adult) During the event, the children will be provided with milk and cookies while listening to different stories. All children will leave with a special gift from the class teacher to mark the event. There will be no charge for this event.

The admission round is open from Monday 8 November 2021, for parents of children to apply for a Reception or junior school (Year 3) place for September 2022. The statutory national closing date for applications is 15 January 2022.
