Year 2—Junior school admissions for September 2022 - Parents of all current Year 2 children need to make a formal application to Essex County Council for a junior school (Year 3 place). Parents can apply via the website www.essex.gov.uk/admissions. The junior admission round opens on **Monday 8 November 2021**, for parents of children to apply for a junior school (Year 3) place for September 2022. The statutory national closing date for applications is **15 January 2022**. From 8 November 2021, applications can be made online via www.essex.gov.uk/admissions where you can also find information regarding the application process.
