



Make a potato character



We are learning to use different media and materials in original ways, thinking about what to use and it's purpose. We will represent our own ideas through creative activities and try to be really imaginative. We will safely use a variety of materials, tools and techniques .

Instructions

Can you turn a potato into an amazing character?
Your potato can be whatever you want it to be. You could for example create a fairy, wizard, cat, spaceman, cowboy/girl, alien, superhero, princess, whatever you want. Be imaginative and creative. Remember children-You must do all the cutting out, colouring etc. It's your work!
Read on for how to make!

Instructions

There are two ways to do this.

Idea 1

You will need

- Empty boxes e.g. cereal box, old magazine, empty packets etc.
- Scissors, pens, pencils, crayons, gluestick, piece of paper

Draw a large potato shape on paper or the back of a box (e.g. cereal box) and colour it brown.

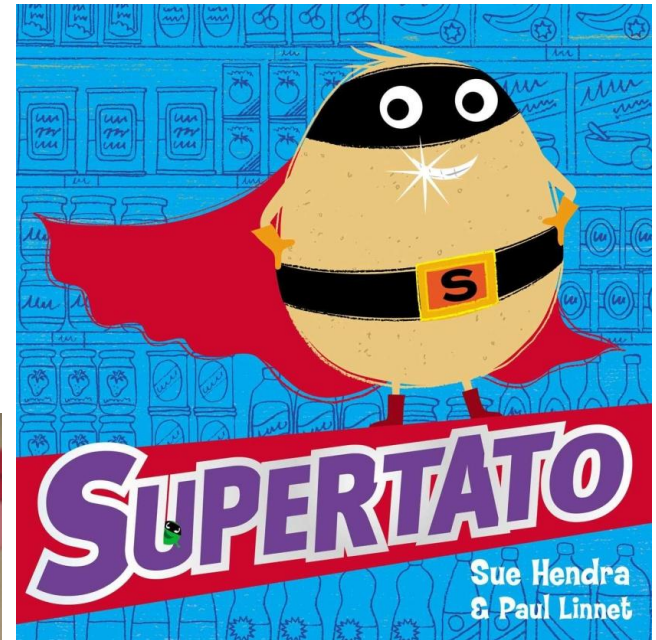


Now add details to your potato to turn it into your character. You can cut out bits from the cardboard packets, boxes and old magazines or you can use pencils, pens/crayons to add the details.

Here are some that I have made. I used empty packets, boxes and magazines for the potato fairy and potato pirate, and colouring pencils for potato Paddington.



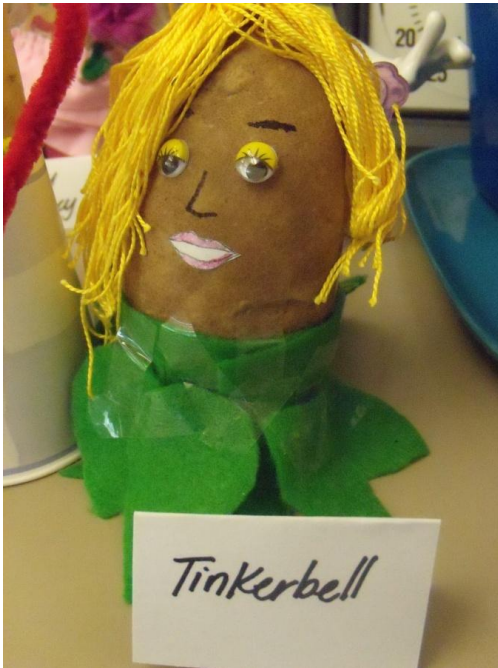
Here are some other ideas.
