

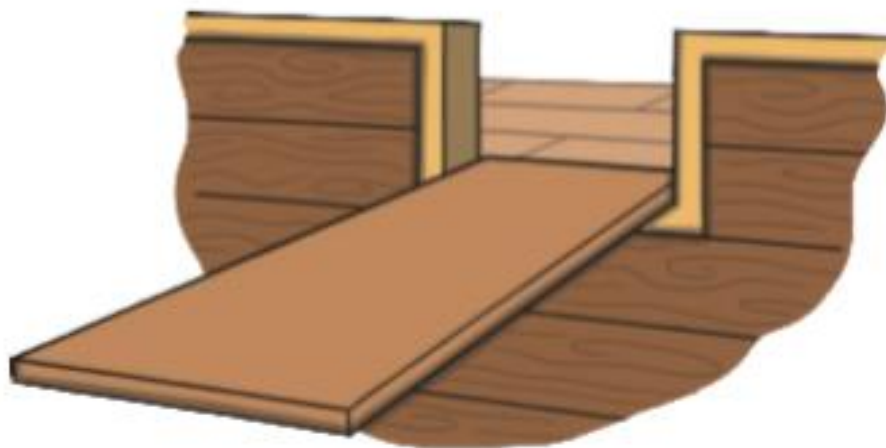
## Talk like a pirate Listening and Movement game

Tell the children that you are the Captain and they are going to be your pirates. As part of their pirate training, the children will need to learn some pirate phrases and do some pirate jobs. Each phrase they learn is accompanied with an action.

Go through the following pages with your child and practise each action. Make sure they know the command which matches each action. Take it in turns to be the Captain and the pirate shipmates. When the Captain shouts a command, the shipmate(s) must do the accompanying action.



**Walk the plank!**



A pirate punishment. Walk along a plank and into the sea.

**Scrub the decks!**



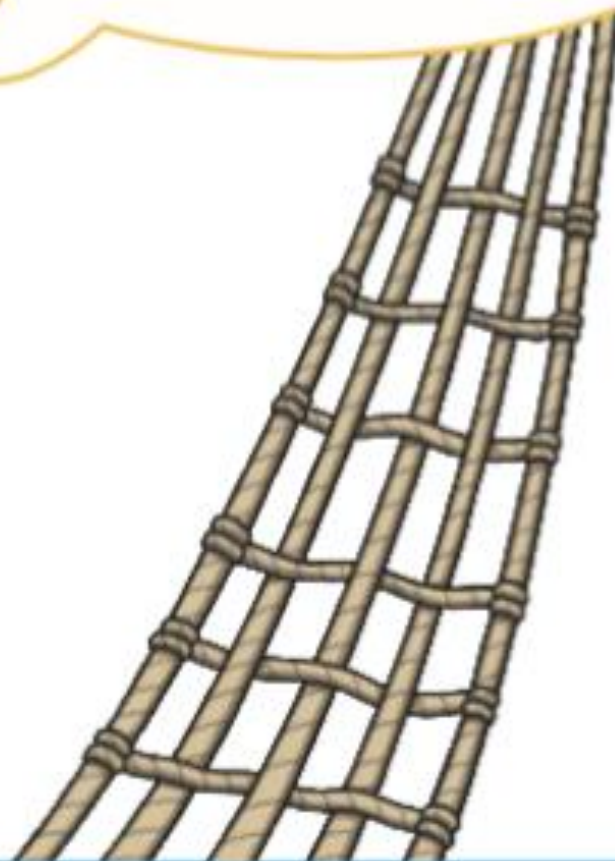
Clean the deck floor of the
