School times for Reception and KS1 children

Can I please remind parents that our main school times have changed back to pre-COVID timings.

I understand that some parents feel that this is quite tight for getting over to the Junior school but please rest assured that the process will get quicker as the children learn the routine and teachers recognise parents more quickly. You can help the process by ensuring that you pick up Year 1 or 2 children first as they are likely to be ready sooner.

Healthy School

Hadleigh Infants and Nursery School is a healthy school and as such we ask that the children bring in a healthy snack to eat during playtime. Please only send your child in with a snack from the following list:

Fresh or dried fruit, vegetables, breadsticks, plain rice cake or plain popcorn.

Children also have the option of a piece of fruit or veg provided free for Infant children—this is offered at story time or another point during the day.
