To enable me to meet as many parents as needed in person or via zoom appointments they will run during the afternoons and evenings on those days. School Photos

On Friday 22nd October the photographer will be in school to take individual photos of the children. If your child does not attend Nursery on a Friday morning but you would like them to have a school photo you may bring them up to school at 9.00am and take them in for their photo. If they have an older sibling in school you will be able to request a group photo at that time.

A few reminders

Please ensure your child brings a clearly named water bottle to school every day - it should only contain water thank you.

Encourage your child to carry in their own bags and water bottles at the beginning of their Nursery session.

Please continue to help your child become more independent with toileting. It is important that children have underwear and clothing they can manage easily, especially when they are in a hurry. We recommend jogging bottoms and leggings.

Check that sweatshirts, jumpers and coats are clearly named – this really helps us to reunite items with their owners quickly.

Please ensure your child brings a coat to school now as it is often cold in our Nursery garden, especially in the mornings.
