Don Sheppard Charity Day - On Monday, we held a joint virtual assembly with Hadleigh Junior School and Don to announce the winner of Don Sheppard Charity Day event. As I has stated previously, HINS did a fantastic job raising £1,009.27. When you compare this total to other comparable events we raised nearly three times as much as we normally do. I just wanted to thank everyone again for the generous donations. Together HINS and HJS raised an incredible £4,302 for Prostate Cancer UK obviously without the support of you all this wouldn't have been possible!
