The National Curriculum	At Hadleigh Infants and Nursery School we follow the programmes of study and the National curriculum to deliver a Geography curriculum which develops their knowledge, skills and understanding of the world. We want pupils to show curiosity towards their local environment, the world and its people.
Barriers for our Children	Some pupils have not had the opportunities to visit towns and different places in the UK and some children have limited experiences of the wider world. This can limit their knowledge when studying Geography.  We are aware that there is a lack of cultural diversity in our local area and that some of our pupils come into school having limited exposure to other cultures.
Implementation	Our Geography curriculum will engage and inspire children to find out more about the world in which they live. They will use their observational, questioning and map skills to learn about their local environment and features of the United Kingdom. Pupils will become knowledgeable about the human and physical features of the UK and other countries in the world. Pupils will be taught specific Geography vocabulary so they are able to talk about the features of the UK and different countries. Pupils will be able to talk about seasonal changes and the weather and how this effects the world. We want children to take an interest in their environment and to look after it in a positive way. Where appropriate children will be given opportunities to investigate the geography of the local area and will use secondary sources to support and widen their understanding of the wider world and different localities.
