## The bean game and ordinal numbers



- Once you have had a few turns of playing the bean game you might be ready to award rosettes for the best shaped bean or have a race to see who is the fastest bean!
- In order to do this you will need to do the following:
- 1. Talk to your grown up about ordinal numbers- we use numbers to describe what order things come in like  $1^{st}$ ,  $2^{nd}$ ,  $3^{rd}$ ,  $4^{th}$ .

2. If you have paper, pens/pencils and scissors then you can make your own rosettes to award!

Don't forget to write on them 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> etc so that you don't get confused when you award them. Take your time making them and try to think about the shape a rosette would be, how you can cut the shape carefully and any decorations you want to add.

- You could use toys that you have to take part in the game as well!
- When you are awarding the rosettes don't forget to say 'Well done' to everyone who took part. If somebody
  doesn't come first you could say to them 'Well done for trying hard, you might come first next time!'
