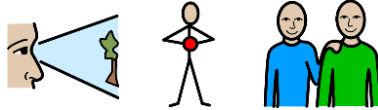


Back to School



We are going back to school. We will be able to see



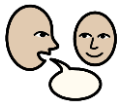
some friends and children we know. It is ok to feel

The classrooms will look a bit different but this helps us

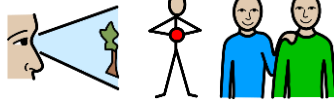


to keep safe. We will put our belongings in a tray on



our table and sit at our table to complete our learning.

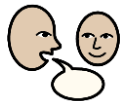
We will only use the things on our own tables or our



own belongings. I will see other children but must



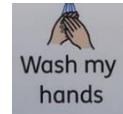
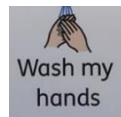
follow the 2 metre rule. The adults in school will



remind us of the rules everyday.

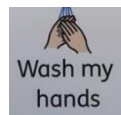
Keeping Safe from Germs

We must remember to keep safe from germs. We must



keep our hands clean. We should remember to wash

our hands if we touch our faces. It is important that



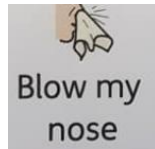
we wash our hands when we have been to the toilet. It

is important that we follow the 'catch it, bin it, kill it'

rules when we cough or sneeze.



Catch it, Bin it, Kill it



If we need to blow our noses, cough or sneeze we



should do it into a tissue, put the tissue in the bin then wash our hands. If we do not have a tissue we need to cover our cough or sneeze by coughing or sneezing into our elbow.

our classroom. We must remember the 2m rule. We

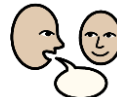
will play on an area of the field with children from our



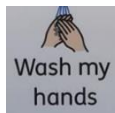
classroom. We will be able to talk to our friends,

us to play. If it rains, the adult will explain what to do in



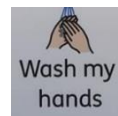
the classroom. We will wash our hands after playtime

Lunchtime

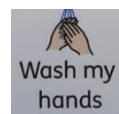
We will eat our lunch in the classroom. We will wash

lunch from home or school and sit at our own tables.

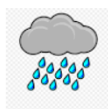


When we are finished eating we will wash our hands

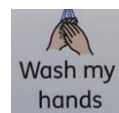


and go out to play. We must remember the 2m rule.

Grown ups will be there to help us to play and follow

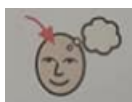


the same rules as playtime. If it rains, the adults will
