

Self-Isolation and Testing Guidance





30 Second Intervention

I've noticed (the inappropriate behaviour)

This means you have broken our school rule of (Respect/Ready/Safe)

You have chosen (state the consequence)

Do you remember last week/ yesterday/ earlier when you (state positive) That's the person I need to see today.
