PE

From Monday 13th September, the children will need come to school wearing active wear on the days that they have PE. The children can wear jogging bottoms, shorts, sports leggings, t-shirts, jumpers, hoodies and any other type of clothing you may wear when completing physical activity. The clothes the children wear on their PE sessions do not have to be in keeping with the school colours. All classes will have PE twice a week -

If you require any additional support with supply of PE kit, please contact Mrs Burls by phoning the main office. No jewellery should be worn on PE days. Staff will not be able to take earrings out and tape is no longer to be used to cover jewellery. If your child arrives at school on their PE day wearing jewellery, they will not be able to take part.

Reading books

During the past few days, the adults in your child's class have been assessing your child's reading levels to ensure that their new reading books are accurate considering their age and ability. Reading books will be sent home from Monday. This year, the children will be able to change their books on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. More information about reading will be provided at the curriculum meetings.

Curriculum Meetings

During the week beginning 20th September 2021, the teachers from each year group will hold a curriculum meeting. Parents will have the option to attend in person (in the Hall) or attend the meeting virtually (via Zoom). The meetings will allow the teachers to explain all the information linked to curriculum, homework and the expectations for their child's new year group. Each year group will hold two meetings one at 10am and one at 6pm. If you are unable to attend either meeting, you will be able to access all of the paper work and presentations on the school's website by Monday 4th October 2021. The dates for the individual year groups can be found on the first page of this news-letter. If parents would like to join the meeting virtually, the login details and passwords will be supplied next week. In order to make the event as safe as possible, I would ask that any parent who would like to attend the event in person completes a LFT before. This is not mandatory and no one will ask to see proof of your result - it is designed to be an additional protective measure. Thank you in advance for your support with this matter.

The platform markets itself as 'an alternative to *Omegle*, with a *TikTok* vibe'. Online safety experts reviewed and tested this platform and have found that it contains large amounts of inappropriate, disturbing, and harmful content transmitted via web cameras.

App information: Monkey is a social chatting app that uses live-streaming to randomly connect you with other users. By using the app, you can collect bananas which can be used to buy merchandise.
