This week has been anti-bullying week nationwide, we started our week with Odd Sock day and have continued to focus on kindness to others throughout. A bully is defined as someone who purposely hurts, threatens or ridicules someone repeatedly. When our children use the word "bully", it is important to hold in mind this definition, as an experience when someone is unkind is not necessarily a bullying situation. Having a conversation with your child about how many times the unkindness has occurred or whether it was intentional can help us get a

clearer understanding of the situation.

Admissions


The Primary and Junior School admissions has opened for Parents to apply for Reception and Year 3 school places for the academic year that starts in September 2024.
