	- Say about things that happened when I was little.

	- Put objects in chronological order from recent history.		
	- Use words and phrases like old, new and a long time ago.		
	- Understand that we had a queen who ruled us and that Britain has had a king or queen for		
	many years.		
	- Learn to appreciate that some famous people have helped our lives be better today.

	- I can link colours to natural and man-made objects.		
	- I can name the primary and secondary colours.
