

Message from Mrs Fynn

As I mentioned in last weeks newsletter, following Covid we have found that many children are finding certain things harder, both in and outside of school. This includes resilience in both learning and social situations, and perseverance when things are hard or go wrong. We have also noticed that some children are more worried about taking everyday risks or making mistakes. With this in mind, we focusing on the Growth Mindset approach, this means that we are reinforcing to the children that we are not born with certain skills or a certain level of intelligence and that through practise and learning from our mistakes we are able to achieve much more in all areas of life. This week in reading assembly the children read the story of The Dot by Peter H Reynolds, the story tells us about a little girl who was nervous about trying new learning at school, but when she became brave enough to have a go the results were fabulous.

With this in mind, I am excited to tell you that on Friday 24th March each year group will share a workshop with Magic Molly who will teach the children about Growth Mindset and mental well being. At the end of the school day, Magic Molly will be on the school playground where you can go and meet her and she will be selling her book and doing a book signing. Magic Molly has visited a few schools in the area recently and the children have really enjoyed meeting her.

We have got a special open day on the 1st April to celebrate Essex County Fire and Rescue Service's 75th anniversary. There will lots of different vehicles and displays to look at on the day.

There will be opportunities for families to get involved in history trails around the museum, craft activities and a chance to sit on the fire engines (and squirt water (3)).
